Bedding

- . Sheets (twin size)
- . Pillow

. Blanket(s)—If bringing a sleeping bag, also bring a sheet or blanket.

Toiletries

- . Several regular-sized for showers
- . 1 or 2 large/beach towels for swimming
- . Washcloths
- . Personal care/toiletries
- . Toothbrush
- . Toothpaste
- . Soap
- . Shampoo
- . Brush and/or comb
- . Deodorant
- . Any other items you use daily

NOTE: Since you may be frequently bending over or have a Camper grasping your clothing, please remember to dress MODESTLY! You will be outside in the heat, and our campers are VERY ACTIVE! You may use more than your average amount of clothes. There is no washer & dryer available for staff or counselors, and you are not allowed to leave the campground! We are going to try to have someone make a laundry run for everyone once or twice but just in case we don't just be prepared.
